	Results interpretation (clear explanation of results with significance to society, clear conclusion)		
DISPLAY	Organization (well organized and visually appealing, interesting use of color and white space, easy to read from distance, may include images of interest)		
	Language accuracy (correct spelling/grammar and avoidance of jargon and slang)
